

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Report on Elocution Course

A voice training and personality development course –'Katha Sona' was introduced in 2016-17 session by the department of Bengali. In the year 2020-21 the department brings this course Elocution as an add-on course of 30 hours.

Elocution emerged as a formal discipline during the eighteenth century. Thomas Sheridan was one of the important figures in this field. The Latin elocutionem is its root, meaning mannar of expression, in Classical Latin it meant public speaking or oratory. Elocution is about keeping vocal identity through a continuous professional guidance for becoming clearer, vocally stronger and more impactful in conversation.

Dhruba Chand Halder College is a rural college with students from backward class background. Their pronunciation is not up to the mark. But they are very much interested to take part in recitation, audio drama, debate etc. organised by the Cultural sub-Committee of the college. The teacher of the dept. of Bengali planned to nurture the interest of the pupil through this short-term course.

The programme was scheduled for 30 hours from 20th September, 2021 to 26th September,2021 in 1st phase and from 8th November,2021 to 15th November, 2021 in the 2nd phase on google platform. The resource person Mrs. Anindita Basu was an eminent orator. Dr Pradip Baidya, departmental teacher also had taken a number of classes as he is a professional and skilled voice trainer. Under their guidance students enjoyed the classes and learnt various skill of voice throwing and speech presentation. 85 students enrolled their names and out of them 80 completed the course. Almost everyday in the evening the classes were held on google meet platform.

This course helps the students to improve the clarity of their voices and speech increasing vocal impact and developing presence and confidence in their voices. This course can reduce anxiety and stress and increase social and work oppertunities. This course helps to develop skill by which students can speak properly in public or in their job- fields. It develops fluency of speaking, stock of words, grammatical accuracy and clear pronunciation. If anyone want to take job in media (in television or radio) or be a professional in the field of drama or recitation – the course will help them. Surely the course will produce a confident, polished and smooth speaker.
