Since Dhruba Chand Halder College is in a rural area in South 24 Parganas, West Bengal, most of the students here find themselves unable to cope up with English, the language of communication in Higher Education. This makes them lose their self-confidence even when they are conversant with any subject. The need to learn English Grammar is felt by a large section of our student population, who wish to pursue higher studies, as well as those desirous of taking competitive examinations, especially in the Government Sector. 

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OUTCOME OF THE ADD-ON-COURSE II

Man is a social animal who needs to communicate with one another on every occasion, at every place and at all times. Communication includes basic skills in talking, expressing and articulating ideas. This is possible only when a student is proficient in the language and its nitty-gritty. This course is a combination of English grammar and ways of talking.

Since our students are from Bengali medium schools, they find it difficult to cope up with English at the Undergraduate level. Many of them are proficient in their subjects of study, but lack the power of expression because of poor knowledge of English grammar. So, the Department of English designed a course that would brush up their grammar skills.

The Department started with 50 students initially, and all of them could complete the course within the stipulated time, and were able to take the examination.


The main problem that we encountered was the students' inability to comprehend and understand the language, in the initial stages. Since they were not accustomed to hearing lectures or conversations in English, it was difficult for them to understand the instructions and suggestions. But, as the course proceeded, the situation began to improve and traces of development soon began to be seen in them. They appeared spontaneous while doing oral lessons in their classes. They were eager to use the black-board to work out the different problems. Moreover, the faculties in charge of giving this course, being known to the learners, an instant rapport was established between the two sections. As a result of this, communication became easier. When the course reached its end, students were found overcoming their fear of the language, and expressing themselves in their own ways
