OUTCOME OF THE ADD-ON-COURSE-1

Teaching a language is possible when there is a small group to deal with, and so, the Department of English started with 50 students, with all of taking the examination at the stipulated time.

The main problem that we encountered was the students' inability to comprehend and understand the language, in the initial stages. Since they were not accustomed to hearing lectures or conversations in English, it was difficult for them to understand the instructions and suggestions. But, as the course proceeded, the situation began to improve and traces of development soon began to be seen in them. Besides having their knowledge of grammar brushed up, they also began to cultivate their interest in topical discussions and other subjects. With the gradual passage of time, our students began to speak amongst themselves in English, pointing out each other's mistakes and correcting these. When the course reached its end, students were found overcoming their fear of the language, and expressing themselves in their own ways. It was felt that these students were then equipped to face interviews and come out more confident and strong.

The outcome of the course had been encouraging. The students enjoyed throughout the course and felt that they were better prepared to face the outside world, ready to plunge into the professional world.


