Report of the relief status – Amphan 2020 in South Bengal

Cyclone Amphan made its landfall in West Bengal between Digha and Haldia on the afternoon of May 20, as a very severe cyclonic storm with sustained wind speeds of 155-165 kilometers per hour spiraling up to 185 kilometers per hour. The coastal state of Orissa and neighboring country of Bangladesh were also impacted by the cyclone.

Cyclone Amphan, hit West Bengal claiming 86 lives so far and affecting over 10 million people in the south Bengal. The powerful storm in West Bengal caused massive damage to standing crops, thousands of trees were uprooted and power (electric) and water supply was interrupted in the south Bengal.

Dhruba Chand Halder College situated in South 24 Parganas. College building has damaged due to this disaster. Student of the college are affected by the cyclone Amphan. Many of students are come across the area of sundarban. There are so many villages of Sundarban and Souh 24 parganas has badly affected by this disaster. Their basic livelihood amenities and practices has been totally damaged due to cyclonic incident.


