Covid-19 : Reshaping the World of Education

Concept Note

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused the largest disruption of education in history, having already had a near universal impact on learners and teachers around the world.

One of the most visible impact of coronavirus is the growth of remote working. In education, as in theatre, the show must go on: that is why teachers have turned to remote learning as an alternative. Distance learning has been around longer than most people realize, but the current state of emergency has forced a faster pace of change for which many are ill-prepared.

While some believe that the unplanned and rapid move to online learning –with no training, insufficient bandwidth, and little preparation – will result in a poor user experience that is un conducive to sustained growth, others believe that a new hybrid model of education will emerge, with significant benefits,

wherein traditional offline learning and e-learning can go hand in hand. Ensuring learning continuity during the time of school closures is a worldwide priority, requiring teachers to move to online delivery of lessons.

The secret of change is to focus all your energy not on fighting the old, but on building the new. At this point, we do observe a silver lining for the grey cloud of COVID-19 by stating that we definitely could not have had the opportunity to bring so many eminent personalities under one roof whose talk all through shall enrich the students and show them new avenues of thought.
