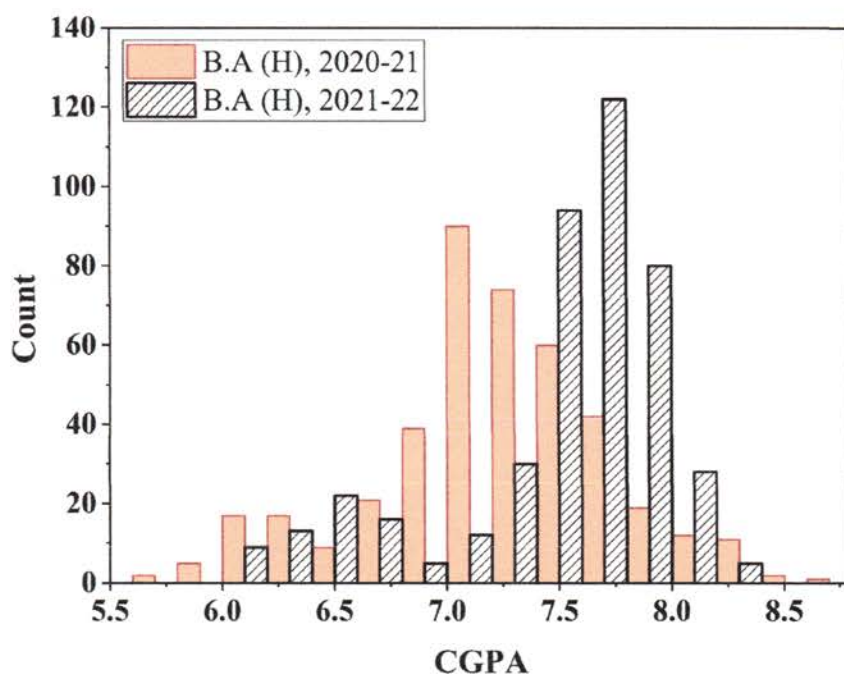


Fig. 1 Distribution of grades awarded to the B.A (Honours) students for the academic year 2020-21 and 2021-22.

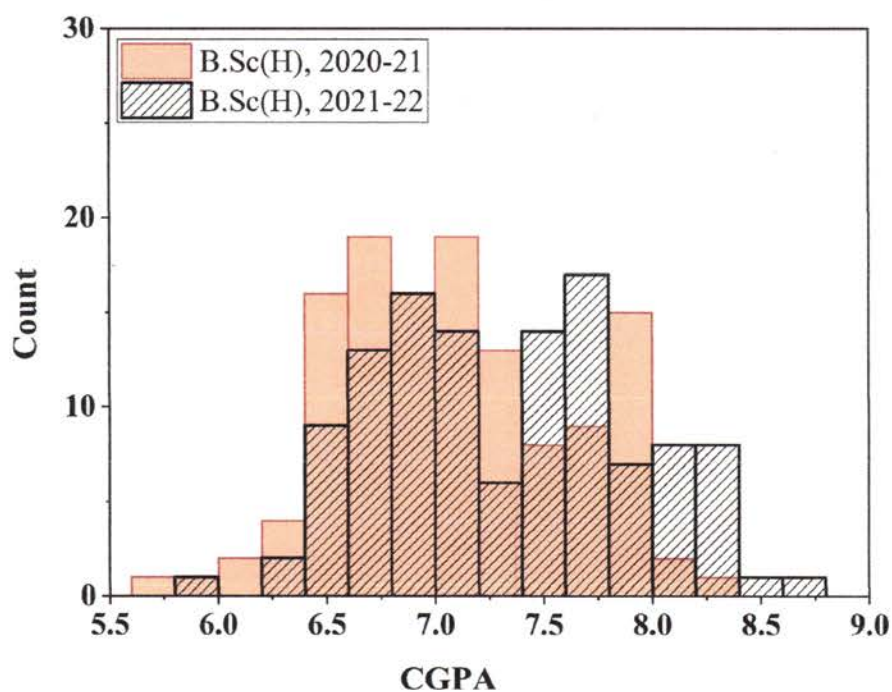



Fig. 2 Distribution of grades awarded to the B.Sc (Honours) students for the academic year 2020-21 and 2021-22.

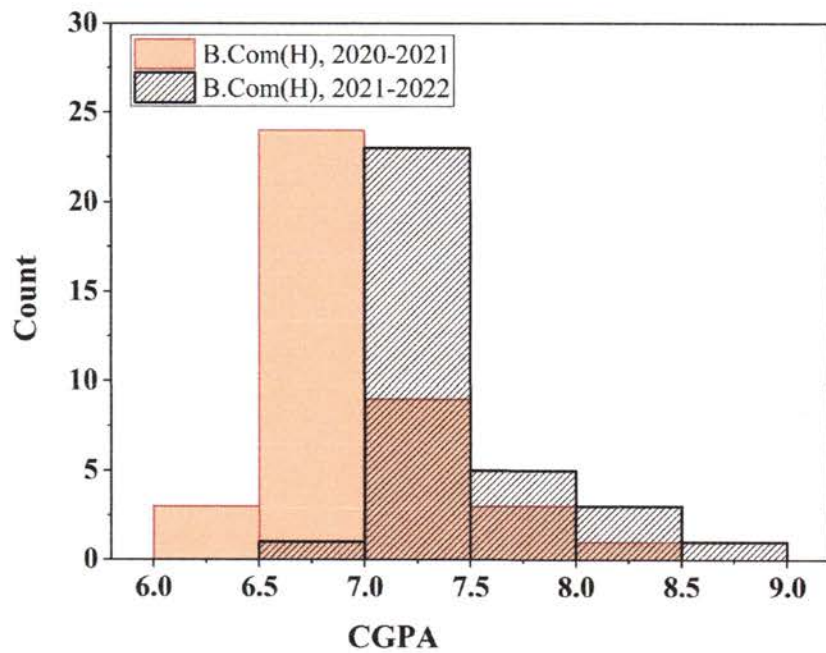


Fig.3 Distribution of grades awarded to the B.Com (Honours) students for the academic year 2020-21 and 2021-2022.

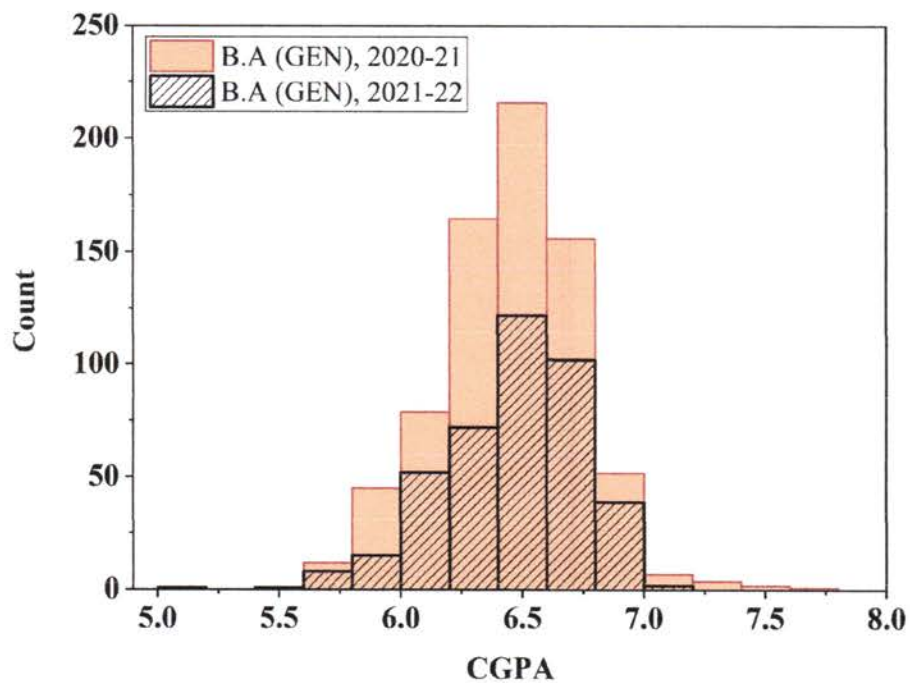



Fig.4 Distribution of grades awarded to the B.A(General) students for the academic year 2020-21 and 2021-2022.

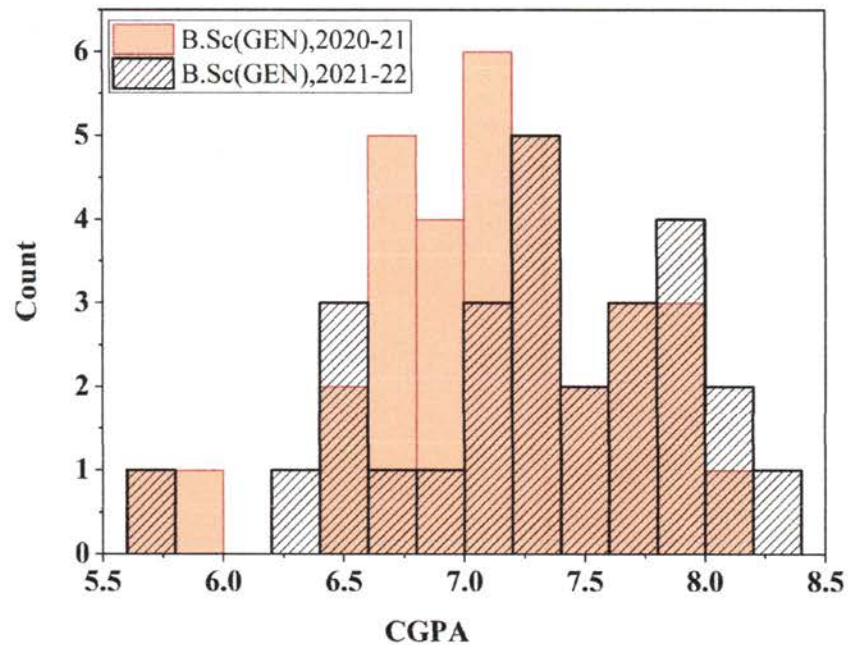


Fig.5 Distribution of grades awarded to the B.Sc (General) students for the academic year 2020-21 and 2021-2022.

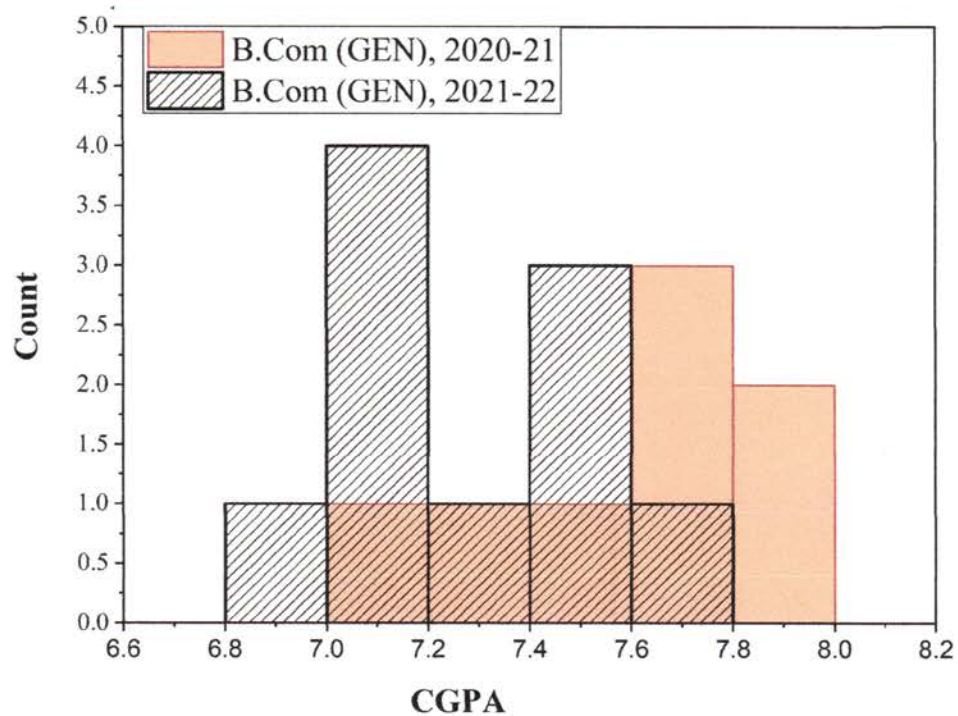



Fig.6 Distribution of grades awarded to the B.com (General) students for the academic year 2020-21 and 2021-2022.

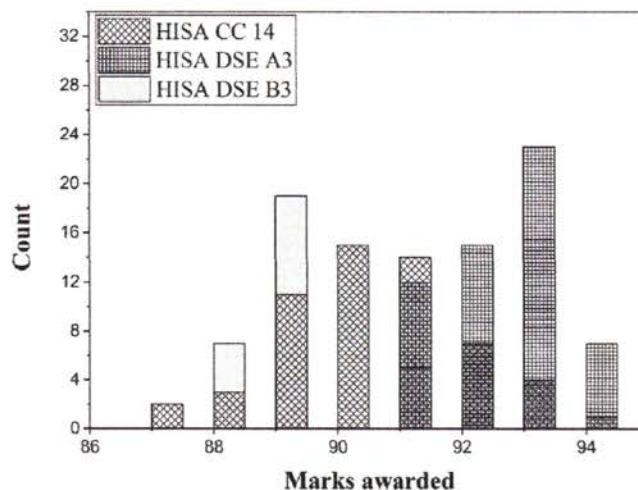


Fig.7 Distribution of marks awarded to the B.A HISA (History Honours) students for the academic year 2020-21.

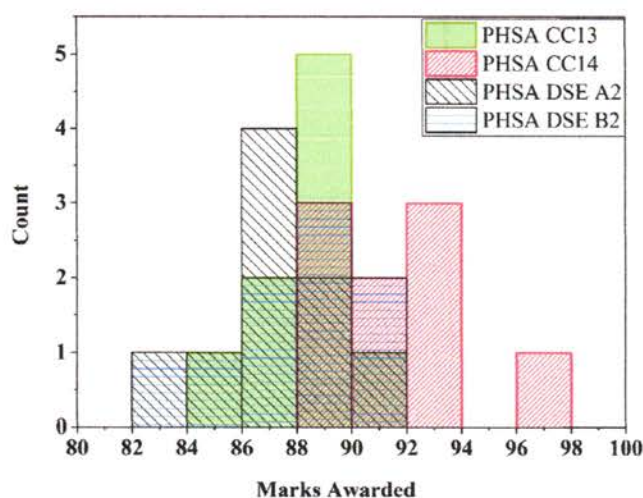


Fig.8 Distribution of marks awarded to the B.Sc PHSA (Physics Honours) students for the academic year 2020-21.

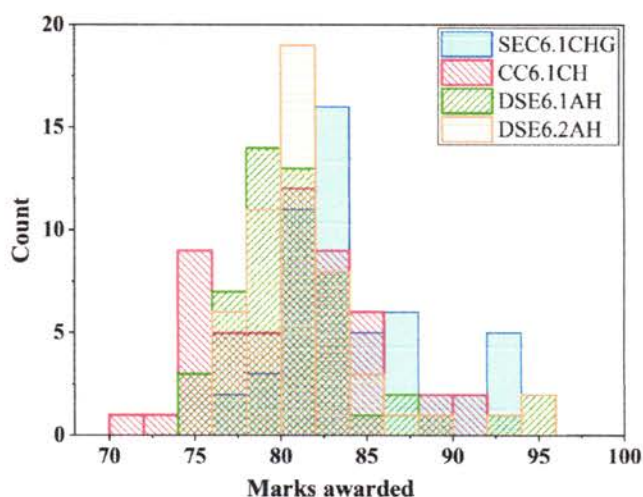

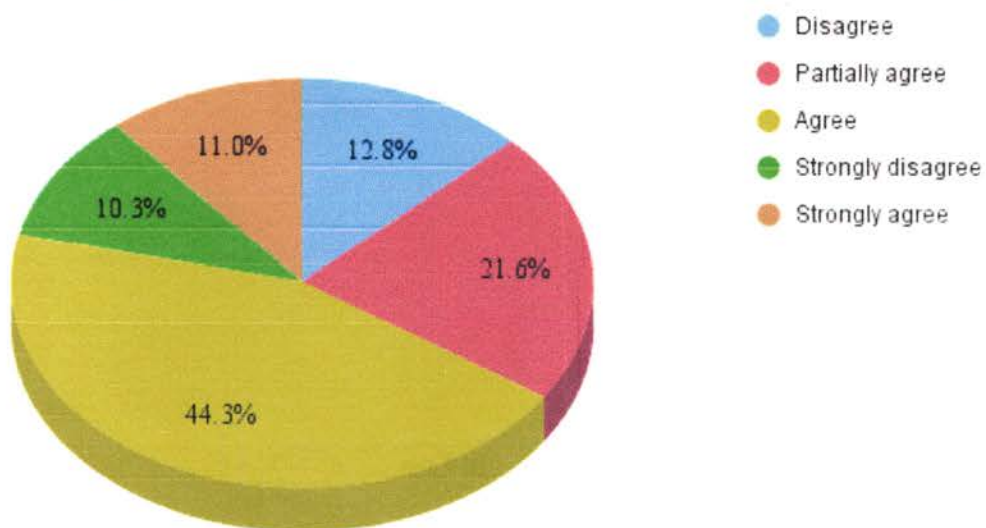


Fig.9 Distribution of marks awarded to the BCom (Honours) students for the academic year 2020-21.

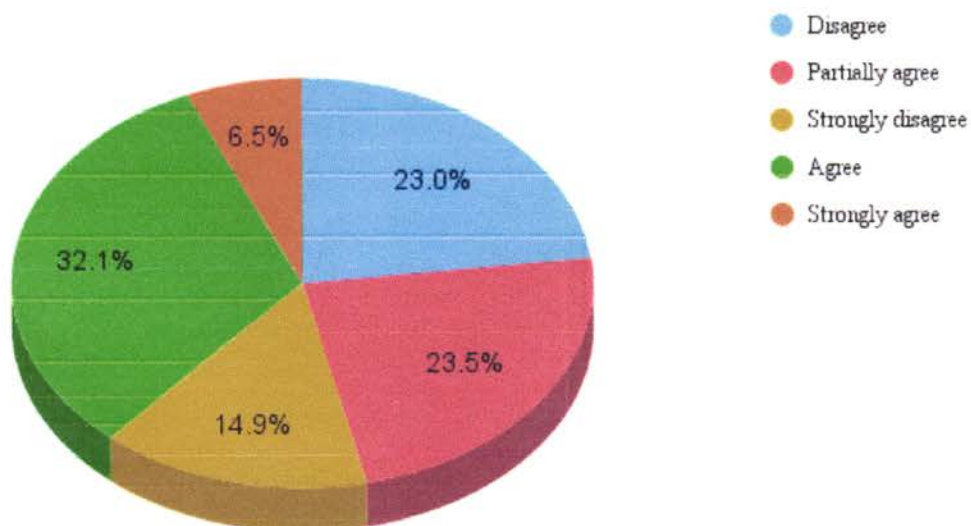
